Any qualified individual who requests an auxiliary aid or service for effective communication or a modification of policies or procedures to participate in a service, program, or activity of the Columbiana County Court of Common Pleas, General and Domestic Relations Division, should make the request by contacting the one of the Court's ADA Coordinators as soon as possible but no later than-two (2) business days before the scheduled event. Please note, the Court's ADA Coordinators cannot administratively grant, as an ADA accommodation, a request that involves a judicial balancing of the rights of the parties or the judge/magistrate's inherent power to manage the courtroom and the proceeding. For example, requests for extension of time, change or venue, or participation in court proceedings by telephone or videoconferencing must be submitted by written motion to the judge or magistrate as part of the case. If your request is the type of request that only a judge or magistrate can grant or deny, the ADA Coordinator will notify you that the request (or part of it) must be directed to the judge or magistrate presiding over your case.

The ADA does not require the Columbiana County Court of Common Pleas, General and Domestic Relations Division, to take any action that would fundamentally alter the nature of its programs or services or impose an undue financial or administrative burden.

The Columbiana County Court of Common Pleas, General and Domestic Relations Division, will not place a surcharge on a qualified individual with either a physical or mental disability or any group of individuals with disabilities to cover the cost of providing auxiliary aids/services or reasonable modifications of policy, such as retrieving items from locations that are open to the public but are not accessible to persons who use wheelchairs.
